This will be a permanent, part time post. The role would suit someone with experience in a catering environment however full training can be given. You will work as part of a team, under the direction of the Bowhill Kitchen Manager.

The majority of your shift will, initially, be based at St Thomas Primary School.

St Thomas Primary is situated just over the river Exe near the centre of Exeter. We want our children to *REACH for their dreams* by following our school values: Respect, Equality, Aspiration, Community and Harmony. We have a very supportive community and are striving to achieve high standards in everything that we do.

The main purpose of the role would be to assist in the service of food to pupils and maintaining the cleanliness and hygiene of the kitchen, dining room and food service areas. Some basic food preparation will also be required.
